

# The Run For A Million, Inc. Terms & Conditions

## STABLING

The stalls at the South Point Arena are permanent 10 x 10. **ALL STALLS MUST BE ORDERED ONLINE | DEADLINE AUGUST 1, 2021.** Stalls will be available starting at **10:00am Sunday, August 15**, at a fee of **\$315 per stall/each stall includes 6 bags of white pine shavings and two rubber mats.** Priority stall placement is given to event sponsors. No refunds on stalls after deadlines. Move out Sunday, August 22 by 10:00AM. The South Point Event and Equestrian Center restricts the use of refrigerators in horse stalls. South Point Equestrian Center Rules/Fire Marshall Regulations specify that at no time should there be feed, bedding, tack, and/or grooming items stored in stall aisles. **All these items MUST be stored in stalls.** THESE IS A FIRE MARSHALL REGULATIONS AND ARE SUBJECT TO FINES IMPOSED BY SUCH! \$100 FINE PER OCCURENCE.

## DAMAGE

Individuals will be responsible for any physical damage inflicted to South Point Arena property and will reimburse the show management for such damage as it may be charged. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and shall be billed accordingly.

## DRUG TESTING

Random drug tested will be taking place throughout the event. Testing will be performed by veterinarians and vet technicians sent to the event by the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and the National Reining Horse Association.

## PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

No outside video or photography is allowed. Competitors are encouraged to purchase videos and photos from the official show cinematographer and images from the official photographer. By way of entry into the event, competitors, and their respective employees, agents and family members grant the permission without remuneration for the use and public distribution of their image, likeness, voice and video for the possible promotion of the event. All exhibitors will be subject to the use of photographers and cinematographers under the direction of show management for the benefit of show promotion. No exhibitor will be allowed the discretionary use of his or her services. **ONLY THE OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHER WILL BE ALLOWED TO SELL PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE RUN FOR A MILLION HORSE SHOW.** All images pertaining to or in relation to The Run For A Million Horse Show are under the sole ownership of The Run For A Million, Inc. and Brumley Management Group, Inc.

**PRESS PASSES:** Only reporters assigned by recognized newspapers, radio or television or the Associated Press will be issued press passes. Requests for press passes **MUST** be sent in writing, emailed to [brumleyevents@gmail.com](mailto:brumleyevents@gmail.com), on the letterhead of the newspaper, magazine or broadcast outlet and signed by the editor and received by management 14 days prior to event. Absolutely no photos can be taken using cell phones or personal cameras of the Million Dollar Competition. Posting competition images and results of the Million Dollar Competition on any form of social media, website and print media until after September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 is strictly forbidden and could result in a breach of confidentiality, by doing so The Run For A Million, Inc. shall be entitled to seek any remedy available by law. Photographers and camera crews who have not followed these guidelines will be escorted out of the facility by security.

The event taking place in this area (South Point Arena and Equestrian Center) is being videotaped/recorded for a Truly Original, LLC ("Company") program currently entitled "The Last Cowboy" (the "Series"). By entering this competition you hereby irrevocably grant to Company and its affiliates and assigns (including without limitation event and program sponsors, advertisers, and marketing partners) the right to photograph your image and record your voice, and to own, license, assign and/or use the same (and/or any portion thereof) forever and throughout the world in any manner and/or medium including, without limitation, in Company and other sponsored or unsponsored programming and the advertisement and promotion thereof. You will not receive any payment for such use and waive any right to bring any action in law or equity against Company, its parent and related companies, subsidiaries (whether or not wholly-owned), affiliates, divisions, and their past, present and future officers, agents, representatives, employees, successors and assigns for such use.

In view of the fact that my participation in the event will bring me into close contact with many confidential elements of the Series not readily available to the public, and disclosure thereof will eliminate the surprise of the Series for the viewing public, I agree to keep and retain in the strictest confidence all information I receive as competitor concerning or relating to the Series. My confidentiality obligations hereunder shall apply to any and all media whatsoever, including, without limitation, any social media or any other website, service, platform, program, application or other form or method of communication, whether now known or hereinafter devised. For example and for the sake of clarity, I may not make disclosures prohibited hereunder via Facebook, Twitter, YouTube or any other similar website or service, whether existing now or in the future.

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS & CERTIFICATES

Health requirements for the State of Nevada will be followed. Owners/agents are required to present a 30-day ORIGINAL health certificate, and 6-month Coggins. Make sure horse registration name is listed on the paperwork. Papers are required to be presented to the show office at check in.

## LIABILITY

By participating in The Run For A Million, all competitors agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the show and the governing body NRHA. In addition, acknowledge that horses are dangerous animals and can be hazardous. By participating in the competition with this knowledge of the danger involved the competitor agrees to accept any and all risks of injury or death. A Release of Liability must be signed by every exhibitor and horse owner participating in the competition prior to receiving their entry number.

## RULES/CHANGES

The Run For A Million, Inc. and Brumley Management Group, Inc. reserve the right to make additions or changes to this event at any time. Show management has the authority to enforce all terms and conditions referring to the show and may excuse any horse or exhibitor from the show prior to, during or after the judging without refunds. The show management reserves the right to interpret these terms and conditions. All decisions are final. By way of making an entry, the exhibitor is assuming responsibility for knowledge of these terms and conditions and releases show management from any claims or losses. The show management reserves the right to modify or change the terms and conditions for The Run For A Million event at any time. All decisions of the judges are final.

## RIGHT TO CANCEL

The show management reserves the right to cancel the event without notice at any time prior to the contest and without liability to the show management. In the event of such cancellation, entry fees or other show fees paid in advance shall be refunded. The show management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these terms and conditions shall be decided by show management, its decision to be final. **SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES TO ITSELF THE RIGHT TO REFUSE, ACCEPT CONDITIONALLY, OR TO CANCEL ANY ENTRIES, DISQUALIFY ANY RIDERS OR EXHIBITORS, PROHIBIT EXHIBITION OF ENTRIES AND CANCEL OR CHANGE AWARD PRIZES, WITHOUT CLAIM OF DAMAGES.** Every horse entered herein for competition will be under control of the show management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any theft, loss or damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold The Run For A Million, Inc. Brumley Management Group, Inc, officials, employees, Directors, Sponsors, the South Point Arena and Equestrian Center, and Gaughan South LLC blameless for any loss or accident to horse(s), family members, employees, or equipment.

## SECURITY

The South Point Arena will be providing security to the barns and arenas. Entrance to the barns will not be allowed without the proper event credentials. Neither The South Point Arena, The Run For A Million Inc. or Brumley Management Group, Inc. are responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items. There are designated areas to park cars, trucks and trailers. It is required that all trailers be parked in designated parking areas only. Parking in undesignated parking areas will subject to \$100 fine per occurrence.

## DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

**FAILURE TO PAY:** Any fees associated with the entry of a horse in The Run For A Million, Inc., including but not limited to entry fees, administrative fees, stall fees, sponsorships, etc. which are not paid in full within 30 days of the close of the event will result in owner of horse or sponsor's immediate suspension from competing in or participating in any further Brumley Management Group, LLC events until amount owed and any late and/or NSF fees are paid in full.

**BEHAVIOR, CONDUCT AND ANIMAL WELFARE:** Any action of disrespect, deceit, slander or fraud directed to the event, show management, grounds crew, show representatives, sponsors or judges will result in disqualification from competition and removal from the facility. No entry, administrative fees or stall refunds will be provided. Individuals accused of unsportsmanlike conduct will be subject to the disciplinary procedures set forth by the National Reining Horse Association in Article A of the handbook. Anyone found to be abusing animals will be disqualified and reported to NRHA. **IN ADDITION, THESE INDIVIDUALS WILL BE SUSPENDED FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY BRUMLEY MANAGEMENT GROUP, LLC EVENTS FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE YEAR.** Reinstatement of the right to exhibit is based on review by BMG production and show management.

**DRAGS:** All event competition will have a drag after every six (6) horses in the draw. The drag **WILL NOT** be moved due to scratches.

**PRE-CHECK:** All exhibitors will be subject to check of equipment and horse inspection prior to competing. Once exhibitor has received their pre-check the horse cannot leave the back paddock area. After horse has received a pre-check inspection and needs to leave the back paddock area prior to competing, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to present their horse again to the pre-check judge for inspection. Failure to do so will result in disqualification without any reimbursement of entry fees. All arenas will be monitored.

**MILLION DOLLAR COMPETITION:** There are no entry fees required.

**OPEN SHOOT OUT DIVISIONS PRE-REGISTRATION:** (Must be **received** by August 1)

Submission of completed Open Shootout Entry Form, one per horse, NRHA Competition License and Owner/Rider current NRHA Membership cards, and signed Participation Liability Release must be **received** by August 1 for entry to be considered complete and avoid the \$350 Post Registration Fee. Payment of entry is required in full at time of submission. To pay by credit card, The Run For A Million Credit Card Authorization Form must be filled out and submitted by required deadline. Exhibitors can compete on up to three horses. This division is open to ANY rider, professional or non-professional. No age requirement for horses. Horses must be shown one handed in any legal bridle. NRHA CATEGORY 1 APPROVED. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES IF THEY WILL BE RECEIVED BY SHOW MANAGEMENT AFTER AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup>**

**FREESTYLE INVITATIONAL PRE-REGISTRATION:** (Must be **received** by August 1)

Entries into this division are by invitation only. Riders will be notified by show management upon acceptance. Submission of completed Invitational Freestyle Entry Form, one per horse, NRHA Competition License and Owner/Rider current NRHA Membership cards, and signed Participation Liability Release must be **received** by August 1, for entry to be considered complete and avoid the \$350 Post Registration Fee. Payment of entry is required in full at time of submission. To pay by credit card, The Run For A Million Credit Card Authorization Form must be filled out and submitted by required deadline. NRHA CATEGORY 9 APPROVED. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES IF THEY WILL BE RECEIVED BY SHOW MANAGEMENT AFTER AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup> FREESTYLE PERFORMANCE IS LIMITED TO FOUR MINUTES.**

**NON PRO AND ROOKIE CHAMPIONSHIP PRE-REGISTRATION:** (Must be **received** by August 1)

Entries into this division are by qualification only. Exhibitors are not required to compete on the horse used to qualify. Non Pro exhibitors must own the horse used to compete, or have a lease on file with NRHA, see NRHA rule book for information. There is a list of qualifying events on event website [www.trfam.com](http://www.trfam.com) Submission of completed Championship Entry Form, one per horse, NRHA Competition License and Owner/Rider current NRHA Membership cards, and signed Participation Liability Release must be **received** by August 1, for entry to be considered complete and avoid the \$350 Post Registration Fee. Payment of entry is required in full at time of submission. To pay by credit card, The Run For A Million Credit Card Authorization Form must be filled out and submitted by required deadline. NRHA CATEGORY 11 APPROVED. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES IF THEY WILL BE RECEIVED BY SHOW MANAGEMENT AFTER AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup>**

**INVITATIONAL FENCE WORK CHALLENGE PRE-REGISTRATION:** (Must be **received** by August 1)

Entries into this division are by invitation only. Submission of completed Entry Form, Owner/Rider, and signed Participation Liability Release must be **received** by August 1, for entry to be considered complete and avoid the \$350 Post Registration Fee. Payment of entry is required in full at time of submission. To pay by credit card, The Run For A Million Credit Card Authorization Form must be filled out and submitted by required deadline. **DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES IF THEY WILL BE RECEIVED BY SHOW MANAGEMENT AFTER AUGUST 1<sup>ST</sup>** \$365 Cattle fee applies to each entry.

## FEES

Each horse entered in the event will be assessed a one-time Administration Fee of \$85.00, a one-time Photography Fee of \$25.00, a one-time Video Fee of \$25.00 and a one-time NRHA judges fee of \$7.00 (excluding Fence Challenge entries). The Administration fee is non-refundable. **Trainers are responsible for making sure all stall fees are paid in full prior to leaving the facility.**

## REFUNDS

After entry deadlines, an entry will receive a refund of entry fees with submission of veterinary certificate stating the horse is unable to compete due to health reasons. Horses may be substituted, based on management's discretion. During the competition dates, August 15-17, 2019 no fees are refundable for any reason.

## PRIZE MONEY

**MILLION DOLLAR COMPETITION:** See custom payback schedule for payouts.

**FENCE WORK CHALLENGE:** See custom payback schedule for payouts.

**SHOOT OUT AND NON PRO CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISIONS:** The Run For A Million will retain 50% of each division entry fee collected. NRHA requires 5% of entry fee. Balance of entry fees will be added to the overall purse of each division. NRHA payback Schedule A percentage utilized.

**ROOKIE CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISIONS** The Run For A Million will retain 50% of each division entry fee collected. NRHA requires 5% of entry fee. Balance of entry fees will be added to the overall Jackpot purse. NRHA payback Schedule A percentage utilized.

**AWARD PAYOUT CHECKS** Payouts will not be mailed out without the proper EIN or Social Security Number of Payee. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to provide the show office with all pertinent tax information. Checks will be mailed once management receives NRHA approval of results. If NRHA does not return approved results to show management within 30 days after the last day of the event, checks will be mailed out to abide by NRHA's 35 day payout rule requirement. If checks are mailed out prior to show management receiving NRHA result approval, The Run For A Million, Inc. and Brumley Management Group, Inc. will not be held liable for any prize money or awards not returned to show management by those who are disqualified by NRHA. Those who fail to provide payment for outstanding invoices or return disqualified prize money within 10 days of being notified will be **SUSPENDED** from any further Brumley Management Group, Inc events and reported to the NRHA for disciplinary procedures. Any outstanding balances owed will be deducted from payouts. Returned checks will be charge a \$50 NSF Fee. Remaining balances will have 10 days to provide payment in full via cashier's check or credit card (including credit card fee of 3.5%). Payments not received within the designated time may incur penalty fees.

## AWARDS

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up their awards at the event. Awards not picked up at the event will not be shipped. If the exhibitor contacts Brumley Management Group in writing requesting items to be shipped, cost of shipping and a \$25 service fee, plus shipping cost, must be paid by exhibitor prior to shipping.

## DRAWS

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep track of the draws, changes in draws or start times, and potential scratches. Exhibitor will be given three PA announcement calls to come to the in gate. After the third call, exhibitor will be considered a no-show.
